Responsibilities

Service

- Food preparation as required following safe food handling procedures;
- Assists with the packing of Meals on Wheels coolers, soup, and meal bags in conjunction with the Cook and Assistant Cook and volunteers;
- Prepares and delivers Food Service Requests, as required;
- Cleans the kitchen and equipment in accordance with DOH standards;
- Works with other food service employees to ensure optimal cleanliness in the kitchen and dining area;
- Cleans all dishes, pots and pans, as required and operates and maintains the dishwasher and sanitation products;
- Secures the fridge, freezer and food supplies, shipping dock and fire doors as required at end of day;
- Sweeps and mops floors on a daily basis;
- Stocks deliveries, as required;
- Ensures the smooth operation of the Food Service area, along with the Director, Cook and Food Service Assistant;
- Works with a team of volunteers to ensure the smooth operation of the Dining Room;
- Supervises volunteers, when required.
- Other duties as required;
