1.	Call to Order	The meeting was called to order at 3:08 p.m.	
2.	Welcome	Seán K. Kelly, Board President, welcomed virtual and inperson guests to The Good Companions 66 <sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting.  Technical considerations, voting rules and methods were reviewed for both in person and virtual participants.  Seán introduced a number of special guests and supporters of The Good Companions, all of which were in virtual attendance:  Catherine McKenny – our City Councillor  Debbie Sullivan, Ministry for Seniors & Accessibility  Cameron Ketchum from the United Way East Ontario  Michelle Hurtubise, Executive Director, Centretown Community Health Centre  And Adam Brisson, partner of our auditing firm, McCay	
3.	Approval of Agenda	Duff LLP  Seán K. Kelly called for a motion to approve the agenda: "Be it so moved that the agenda for the 66th Annual General Meeting be approved as presented". The motion was moved by Robert Dunlop and seconded by Monty (Amitabh) Mukerji, none opposed, motion carried.	
4.	Approval of Minutes	Leah Canning called for a motion to adopt the previous minutes: "Be it so moved that the minutes of the 65th Annual General Meeting, June 28, 2021 be adopted as presented". The motion was moved by Brian Robertson, seconded by Arthur Chartrand, none opposed, motion carried.	
5.	President's Report	Seán K. Kelly spoke to The Good Companions' major accomplishments over the 2021-22 fiscal year. Some highlights included: the Centre's leadership and response	



		during pandemic and disruption during the convoy, the launch of LGBTQ2+ specific programming on Saturdays and walking club, Seniors' Centre Without Wall Expansion (TGC leading expansion of the program across Ontario and into the Atlantic), among many others. Seán urged the audience to review the full Corporate Report for further details and statistical accomplishments.  Special thanks were given to the Board of Directors, the
6.	Treasurer's Report	Staff Team, and to all of The Good Companions' Funders.  Jason Kempt, Treasurer of the Board of Directors presented the 2021-22 audited financial statements of The Good Companions. The year was complete with less than a dollar surplus. Special thanks to Finance Officer, Mariola Kolakowski, who meticulously managed the books of a \$2 million dollar budget (across all funds – Operating, Property and Special Projects).
		As in previous years, the auditors issued a qualified opinion and the basis for the qualification, common to many charitable organizations, is that certain revenue sources such as donor contributions and fundraising are not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. As per the auditor's opinion, the risk of a material misstatement is low so that the cost/resource utilization of implementing additional procedures would not be warranted.
		Member Query (Virtual Chat): Member would like to see additional federal funding for the Centre.  Jason assured everyone that our Executive Director, Monique Doolittle-Romas is aware of all applicable grants and revenues available to The Good Companions, and TGC is in good standing with all of its funders. Monique will continue to apply for funding available that meets The Good Companions' mission and values, and to meet the needs of our membership and clients.
		Jason Kempt called for a motion to accept the audited financial statements of 2021-2022: "Be it so moved that the audited financial statements of 2021-2022 be accepted as presented". Motion was moved by Viola

Motion was moved by Maureen O'Callaghan and seconded by Arthur Chartrand, none opposed, motion carried.

The Nominating committee recommends the following: Angela Dzinas, Amy Friesen, Leann Halpenny, Barbara Parker, and Bonita Goodison to begin a first term as Director, Brian Robertson to begin a second term as Director, and Cathy Collett to begin a third term as Director.
