Earth Day

Earth Day was first celebrated on March 21, 1970. That was the day of the spring equinox, the first day of spring in the northern hemisphere. About a month later, on April 22, 1970, Gaylord Nelson-a United States Senator from Wisconsinorganized an Earth Day celebration focused on the United States and its growing environmental problems. Canada celebrated its first Earth Day on September 11, 1980. Organized by Paul D. Tinari, a graduate student at Queen's University. The first Canadian Earth Day officially opened with a ceremonial tree planting and included educational lectures and trash pick-up by students. It had taken 20 years, but now environmental issues were being seen as important international problems that required worldwide cooperation to solve.
