

The Peanut Gallery

On October 2, 1950, cartoonist Charles Schulz debuted his *Peanuts* comic strip. Schulz actually hated the name

Peanuts. He had originally named the strip L'il Folks, but his publishers feared that this title was too similar to a comic strip called Little Folks. Schulz then decided to call it Good Old Charlie Brown after its lead character, but once again his publishers intervened. Without even seeing the strip, they named it Peanuts, which was a common term for children in the 1950s, thanks to The Howdy Doody Show's "Peanut Gallery." The name stuck, and Charlie Brown, Snoopy, Lucy, Linus, Sally, and the whole Peanuts gang have become international stars, appearing in 2,600 newspapers all around the world.
